WEATHERFAST A1 PENETRATING TIMBER OIL

- **DESCRIPTION:** A penetrating timber oil which will nourish the timber whilst eradicating any organic growth deep within the substrate. Contains biocides and UV inhibitors.
- **USES:** Primary use is to penetrate deep inside the timber to replenish the oils and eradicate any organic growth.

PROPERTIES (at 25°C)

COVERAGE:	8-10 square metres per litre (subject to porosity of timbers).
DRYING TIME:	Touch dry: 1 hour at 25 degrees C and 50% humidity.
RECOATING:	2-3 coats every 30 minutes on the same day.

- **PREPARATION:** The timber **MUST** be clean and dry before commencing. If the timber is grey, use Norglass Grey-Away prior to coating. Any further cleaning of the surface should only be done with Norclean-Plus using a **paper towel**.
- APPLICATION: Stir contents thoroughly before use. Apply using a brush or roller (4mm mohair), 2-3 coats every 30 minutes on the same day. Allow to dry for 2 days before a light sand with 240 grit sand paper, clean with Norclean-Plus then apply A2 finishing coat.
- **TRANSPORTATION:** Flammable liquid. Dangerous Goods Class 3.2. Sizes available - 10litre, 4litre, 2litre, 1litre.
- **PRECAUTIONS:** Provide adequate ventilation during use. Keep away from naked flame and do not smoke. Do not use in damp conditions or below 10 C.
- FIRST AID:If poisoning occurs call a doctor or Poisons Information Centre (Aust) on 13 11 26 or
(NZ) 0800 764 766 and have label information ready.
If swallowed DO NOT induce vomiting. Give large quantities of water or milk. In case of
eye contact, flush immediately with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes and consult a
doctor. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do and continue rinsing. If skin
contact causes irritation, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly. If
breathing difficulty arises remove to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if not breathing.
